*True Myth Winery showcases the best of San Luis Obispo County – a Chardonnay from the cool-climate Edna Valley and a Cabernet Sauvignon from Paso Robles. The Niven Family has been growing Chardonnay on their historic Paragon Vineyard since 1973, showcasing the beautiful tropical flavors of this cool climate estate. Our rich, smooth Cabernet Sauvignon comes from the rugged terrain of Paso Robles just 30 miles to the north. Both wines are rich and delicious and speak to the unique diversity of San Luis Obispo County.*

## CHARDONNAY

Edna Valley provides the coolest growing region in California; just 5.4 miles from the Pacific Ocean – making it a really special place to grow Chardonnay.

Jack Niven pioneered grape growing in the Edna Valley when he planted the first vines of Paragon Vineyard in 1973. Home to the oldest continually producing Chardonnay vines in the region, the Niven Family has owned and farmed Paragon Vineyard for more than 40 years.

True Myth Chardonnay is backed by decades of history, experience and heritage. It is a classically styled Chardonnay with flavors of beautiful tropical fruit, mineral undertones and a creamy mouthfeel all topped off with the perfect complement of vanilla bean and toasted oak.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

It has been proven over time that Paso Robles is hands-down a stellar place to grow Cabernet Sauvignon. Benefitting from the largest swing between high daytime and low nighttime temperatures of any region in California, the climate allows grapes to fully develop solid flavor and varietal character.

No strangers to Paso Robles, the Niven Family have been part of San Luis Obispo County's farming history for more than four decades. They previously owned and farmed a Cabernet vineyard in Paso, and have continually been proponents of keeping Cabernet from Paso in bottles bearing the Paso Robles appellation. Along with winemaker Christian Roguenant, they have tapped into their multi-generational relationships with current growers to source high quality fruit for this wine.

Pure Paso Robles, this Cabernet is rich yet smooth and loaded with elegant flavors of blackberry, blueberry, pepper, and cassis complemented by hints of cedar, cocoa powder and caramelized oak.
